Hernando Book Stampede Recap May - August 2011



Earlier this year the Hernando County Alumni Chapter in cooperation with the Hernando County Public Library System kicked off the inaugural Hernando Book Stampede.

When the Hernando Bulls leadership team planned and executed the Book Stampede in May, they expected some turn out from our members and the local community, but did not expect anything close to the turnout that we received in the end.

By all accounts the 1st annual Hernando Book Stampede was a major success and far exceeded the expectations of not only our chapter, but also of the Hernando County Public Library System.

The Book Stampede was launched on May 30th and ran until August 6th. The goal of the Stampede was to ask USF Alumni, USF students, and those in the local Hernando County Community, to drop off some of their gently used books at their local Hernando County Library Branch office. The primary goal of the Stampede was to collect children's and school age books for the library.

Given the current state of Hernando County's economy the local Library system is in need of assistance from the local community for new books for children and adults.



Due to budget cuts, and cost saving measures enacted by the County, because of the current economic situation in Florida, the Hernando County Library System is short on funding. This is why the chapter decided to lend a helping "horn".

Given the success of the inaugural Hernando Book Stampede the chapter is currently making plans for next year's summer book stampede. The chapter hopes to be able to make next year's event even larger and better than this year's, so we can bring in even more books for the local library system.

Currently the Hernando Book Stampede is the only community outreach/service project of the chapter. As the chapter grows, gets more local volunteers to help run it, and our membership becomes more active, we would love to hold another community outreach/service project in addition to the Book Stampede.
